STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that James Heddon's Sons, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Michigan, and located in the city of Dowagiac, county of Cass, in said State, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for ARTIFICIAL BAITs, in Class No. 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of this corporation since about June 1, 1926.

This corporation is the owner of the Wiggle-King trade-mark registration No. 120,195, granted to it January 15, 1918.

The trade-mark is applied directly to the goods, by stamping the same thereupon, and also to boxes in which the goods are contained by placing thereon a printed label on which the trade-mark is shown.
