

STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

The Enterprise Manufacturing Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Ohio and located at Akron, Ohio, and doing business at 217 Ash Street, Akron, Ohio, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for PORK RIND FISH BAIT, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.
