

STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Superior Door Catch Company, a firm domiciled in and doing business at No. 6323 Hughitt Avenue, Superior, Wisconsin, and composed of the following members, Hiram B. Gallinger and Anna M. Gallinger, citizens of the United States of America, has adopted and used the trademark shown in the accompanying drawing, for FISHING SPOONS, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office, in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905.
