STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents: John Nelson, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Chicago, Illinois, and doing business at 40 North Wells Street, Chicago, Illinois, under the name of Louis Johnson Co., has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for ARTIFICIAL FISH LURES, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.
