## STATEMENT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that The American Fork & Hoe Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Ohio and having its principal place of business in the city of Cleveland, county of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, whose post-office address is 1623 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio, has adopted for its use the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing.
