STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Rain-Beau Products Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and located and doing business at Rockland Street, Canton, Massachusetts, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for FISHING LINES, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended. The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since August 12, 1946.
