(Statement)

Frederick S. Burroughs, a citizen of the United States, residing at Lake Mohawk, Sparta, New Jersey, and doing business as F. S. Burroughs & Co. at 196 E. Blackwell Street, Dover, New Jersey, has adopted and is using the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for ARTIFICIAL FISH LURES, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used in connection with such goods, the trade-mark being applied to the goods by placing on containers therefor a label on which the trade-mark is shown, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office on the Principal Register in accordance with the act of July 5, 1946.

The trade-mark was first used by the applicant on July 28, 1948, and first used in interstate commerce on July 28, 1948.

(Declaration)

Applicant, being duly sworn, deposes and says that he believes himself to be the owner of the trade-mark which is in use in interstate commerce, and that no other person, firm, corporation, or association, to the best of his knowledge and belief, has the right to use such trade-mark in commerce which may lawfully be regulated by Congress, either in the identical form thereof or in such near resemblance thereto as might be calculated to deceive, that the drawing truly represents the trade-mark sought to be registered, that the specimens show the trade-mark as actually used in connection with the goods, and that the facts set forth in the statement are true.
