STATEMENT

Russelure Mfg. Co., Inc., a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of California, located at Los Angeles, California, and doing business at 2514 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles 7, California, has adopted and is using the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for ARTIFICIAL FISH LURES, in Class 22, Games, toys, and sporting goods, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used in connection with such goods, the trade-mark being applied to the goods or to the containers for the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office on the Principal Register in accordance with section 2(f) of the act of July 5, 1946.

The trade-mark was first used on the goods specified on April 8, 1947, and first used on said

goods in commerce among the several States which may lawfully be regulated by Congress on April 8, 1947.

The mark is claimed to have become distinctive of the goods of applicant or its predecessor in commerce which may lawfully be regulated by Congress through substantially exclusive and continuous use thereof as a mark by applicant or its predecessor in commerce among the several States for the five years next preceding the date of the filing of this application.
